

Career Day 2013

Oakland High's annual Career Day took place Tuesday, February 26. Students in 29 different classes heard from 28 speakers, most of whom were Oakland High alumni. The nineteen teachers who participated said their students greatly benefitted from hearing and speaking with the presenters about their occupation, profession and career path.

As occurs each year, speakers shared many stories and anecdotes, which make the career come alive for students. They heard about careers as different as pediatrican, electrical engineer, public relations, and crime lab technician. Hearing about the various aspects of a profession or occupation, students learned about the education needed, the availability of jobs (especially in the current very tight job market), pay and benefits, and the pleasures and challenges of the career. They also learned about the hard work and sacrifices that may be necessary to accomplish one's career objectives.
